

Joint Admission Counselling, Delhi-2017

Frequently Asked Questions

- 1. What is the source of latest information about the Admission, Institute, etc.?**
Latest information is available on www.jacdelhi.nic.in and the individual Institutes' Website.
- 2. When will the applications start?**
Online application process will go on from 8th June 2017 or after that.
- 3. When and where will the list of selected candidates be displayed?**
All the results of provisionally selected candidates will be displayed on www.jacdelhi.nic.in. For details, please go through the admission brochure.

Reservation

- 4. What if a candidate is eligible under two reservation categories?**
The percentage relaxation in that case will be of the category with higher percentage relaxation. (For example, if a student belongs to SC and PW category both then he will be given 10% relaxation i.e. the relaxation applicable for SC category students)
- 5. I am from outside Delhi of PH / OBC category. Am I eligible to apply under these categories?**
Please refer admission brochure for details regarding institute wise eligibility and no. of seats under these categories.
- 6. A student who has done schooling from Delhi can apply under outside Delhi quota or not?**
No
- 7. Who is a Delhi candidate?**
The students who have undertaken qualifying exams (i.e. 12th) from the schools located in Delhi (having PIN CODE of Delhi), irrespective of the location of their hometown, would be considered as "Delhi Candidate".
- 8. Are schools located in NCR but outside Delhi borders considered a Delhi school?**
No, "Delhi" candidates must have undertaken qualifying exams (i.e. 12th) from the schools having PIN CODE of Delhi in their address.
- 9. Are there any seats reserved for various categories?**
Please refer admission brochure for the eligibility and no. of seats under the different categories in each of the participating institute.
- 10. Is there any Relaxation in Marks for Reserved Categories?**
Yes, Candidates belonging to certain reserved categories shall be allowed a concession in the minimum eligibility requirements. Please refer admission brochure for details.
- 11. What is the branch wise seat distribution in the participating institutes?**

- 12. Are there any seats reserved for single girl child candidates?**
One seat in each branch of DTU over and above their normal intake is reserved for Single Girl Child candidate (Girl having no brother and sister) who have passed 10+2 from schools located in NCT of Delhi for admission to B. Tech. courses. No seat is reserved in NSIT, IIITD and IGDTUW for a single girl child.

13. Girl candidate having lost his sibling will be considered as Single Girl Child?

Please refer the Certificate for Single Girl Child to be submitted in support of Single Girl Child quota for your answer to this query.

14. Are there any seats reserved for Central/State Board Topper candidates?

One seat in each branch of DTU over and above their normal intake is earmarked for Central/State Board Topper candidates. No seat is reserved in NSIT, IIITD and IGDTUW for Central/State Board Topper candidates.

15. Do you have any quota for sports and Olympiads?

There is no quota for any of these categories. However, IIITD gives some bonus marks to applicants with specific achievements. For details, please refer admission brochure.

16. What is the validity of Bonus marks?

Scores/Certificates for Bonus fields mentioned in Information brochure will only be considered for giving Bonus marks.

18. I did my 12th schooling from Delhi, however my OBC certificate is issued from other state, will I be considered for Delhi-OBC category benefit?

19. I got less than 60% in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics, but my overall marks are more than 60%, will I be eligible for admission in NSIT, DTU and IGDTUW?

No. A student is eligible only if he/she i) Secured 60 % or more marks in the aggregate of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics, and ii) passed English as a subject of study of the Senior School Certificate Examination Level (Core or Elective). Some relaxation is given to reserved category students, please refer to admission information brochure for details.

20. I got 80% in Mathematics in XII in CBSE, but my aggregate of 5 subjects is less than 80%, will I be eligible for admission in IIIT-Delhi?

No.

21. I obtained 79.99% am i eligible?

You are eligible for applying for DTU, NSIT and IGDTUW (in case you are a Girl candidate) but not IIITD. Some relaxation is given to reserve category students, please refer to admission information brochure for details.

22. I have taken up improvement exam and now have 80% or above marks in mathematics and aggregate. Can I apply for IIITD?

Yes, students who have taken up improvement exam and have now secured 80% or above marks in mathematics and aggregate are eligible to apply for IIITD.

23. I have studied Mathematics as an additional subject in class 12th. Can I apply?

24. I don't have CSE in class 12th. Am I eligible for admission to B.Tech.(CSE)?

Yes

25. I have done 10+2 from NIOS. Am I eligible?

Yes

26. I passed 12th in 2015 can I apply?

Yes, provided you have qualified JEE(main) 2017 and satisfy the eligibility criteria of Counselling.

27. Is there any separate application form for registration-cum-counselling for admissions in NSIT, IIITD, DTU and IGDTUW?

No. A common application form has to be filled on website www.jacdelhi.nic.in

28. What is the last day of fee payment?

29. How will the seats of participating institutes be allotted to candidates?

Seat Allotment in NSIT, DTU & IGDTUW will be strictly based on All India Rank in JEE (Main) –2017. **Seat Allotment in IIITD will be based on IIITD Merit list which will be prepared as (i) total marks obtained in Paper 1 of JEE Main 2017 converted to base of 100 and (ii) bonus marks, if any, which are given for achievements in various areas like Olympiads, innovation, programming contest, national talent search, KVPY, sports, culture, chess, etc. For Details please refer to <https://iiitd.ac.in/sites/default/files/docs/admissions/2017/BTech%20Admission%20Brochure%202017.pdf>**

30. What if I refuse to take admission in the branch allotted to me at the time of admission?

The candidate will not be considered in next phase of counselling except Spot Round (to be held subject to the availability of vacancies).

31. Can a candidate change or re-order their choices, delete earlier choices and add new choices any number of times?

Yes, but only during the registration period only. Once registration period is over, no change will be possible in the choices. Please refer to Admission Information Brochure.

32. Can I change my choices after first counselling?

33. What will happen in case of a tie (two students having same marks) in the merit list of IIIT- Delhi?

In case of a tie, the candidate with higher rank in JEE Mains 2016 as issued by CBSE shall rank higher.

34. Can my parent/guardians attend counselling on my behalf?

Yes, parent/guardians are allowed to attend counselling on behalf of the candidate but only in genuine cases in which candidate can't come himself. The parent / guardian in such case should have an authorization letter signed by the candidate and should have supporting documents in support of the reason for candidate not reporting personally and the reason should be acceptable to reporting center authorities also.

35. Can I send my representative for the SPOT round?

ONLY the candidates who pay the requisite fee will be considered for the SPOT round.

36. How will I be intimated about the second and further rounds of counselling?

You have to regularly visit the website www.jacdelhi.nic.in after the first counselling for further details.

37. Which rank will be considered for the seat allotment for category students?

Seat allotment for all categories will be done on the basis of CRL (All India Rank) and Merit list of IIIT as published.

38. Do we have to send the filled in application form?

Signed copy of Application form needs to be produced at the time of counselling only.

39. What all documents need to be brought for document verification?
